AN EXHIBITION INTERPRETING THE LANDSCAPE

Field Days

Stretching parallel to the Dorset coast, from Broadmayne in the east to Kingston Russell in the west, is a broad ridge of chalky downland known as the South Dorset Ridgeway. With a steep escarpment on the south side and a gently sloping landscape to the north, some 14 square miles within this area contain at least 500 earthworks, showing evidence of man's occupation of the land since prehistoric times.

The touring exhibition, Field Days, features commissioned works from local and national artists who have responded to the archaeology, ecology, geology, ancient myths and legends of the Ridgeway.
