

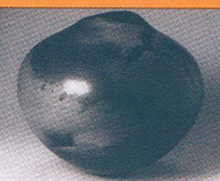
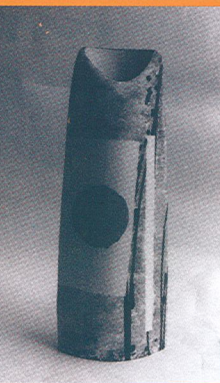

fired up aims to explore the diversity in Ceramic and Glass art.

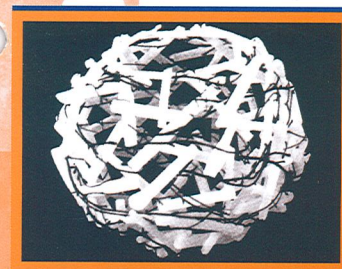
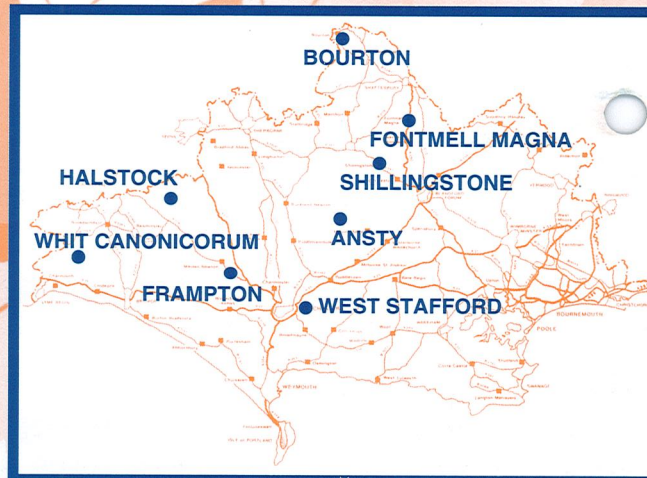
